- No records on file.
- Due to the vacancy an accurate evaluation of drainfield was not possible, a 60 day re-evaluation is required.

## Water Supply System

- Nitrate levels are 9.0 mg/l. Maximum contaminant level is 10.0 mg/l. Recommend annual water sampling at a minimum.
- Sodium levels are over 160 mg/l, which may affect taste. Special diets may require water of low sodium content.
